MiDOG Membership

Step 1) Attend a MANDATORY etiquette class sponsored by MiDOG. Please no dogs allowed for this class.

This one time class is intended to give everyone a few ground rules prior to attending the dog park. It will include some acceptable and non acceptable behaviors for you and your pet and also give you a few tips on healthy interaction with your dog. The class itself is free, lasts about 45 minutes. Please check our website www.MiDOG.org or with the Recreation Authority for location of etiquette class and also the days and times that are available. Seating is limited, in order to reserve a seat please register with the **Recreation Authority at 586-445-5480**.

Step 2) Obtain a current dog license and vaccinations. Please bring proof of dog license(s) and vaccinations expirations when you apply for your membership at the Recreation Authority.

Step 3) Fill out this Application and pay for Membership at the Recreation Authority. **Bring proof of dog license(s) and vaccinations expirations when you apply for your membership.**

Park Rules

- Dog park hours: 6:00 am to 10:00 pm daily, unless otherwise posted.
- You are entering this area at your own risk. The Recreational Authority of Roseville and Eastpointe/MiDOG Organization is not responsible or liable for injuries to dogs, their handlers, or others who enter the park. Owners/handlers are responsible and liable for the actions of their dogs at all times.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the park and you must have the leash in your possession at all times.
- Do not let people or dogs in by holding gate open, each person must key fob in for themselves this protects our park and everyone inside.
- Dogs under 5 months of age are prohibited.
- Dogs must be free of diseases and parasites such as fleas and ticks. No sick dogs are allowed.
- Spaying/neutering of dogs is recommended. Dogs in heat are not allowed.
- No more than 2 dogs per person are permitted within the park at any one visit.
- Dogs must be in view of and within voice control of their owner/handler at all times. No dogs will be left unattended.
- No pets other than dogs are permitted.
- Owners must immediately clean up after their dog(s) and properly dispose of waste.
- Excessive barking is prohibited. Dogs barking excessively must be removed.
- Fill any holes your dog(s) may dig.
- No aggressive dogs or people allowed. Dogs with a known history of, or who exhibit aggressive or dangerous behavior, are prohibited. Immediately leash your dog and leave the park if aggressive behavior is observed.
- No food (including dog treats) or alcoholic beverage of any kind is allowed within the park.
- Park gates must be kept closed at all times.
- Bike riding, skateboarding, rollerblading, and skating are prohibited.
- No children under 5 are allowed in the park. Children ages 5 through 17 must be accompanied by an adult. Strollers are not allowed. No running, shouting, chasing dogs, or petting other people's dogs without the owner's permission.
- Off-leash dog parks are generally self-supervised. Visitors to the park are encouraged to follow the rules and to encourage others to do the same. If there is a problem that is beyond the capacity of the visitors to manage, the Eastpointe Police should be called at 586-445-5100. For emergencies, call 911.
- All rules are subject to change.

Only family members and guests, such as regular dog sitters, listed on this application may use the key fob, and only dogs on this application may be admitted. Key fobs will not be issued until all users on the application have signed it, acknowledging that they understand and agree to all conditions listed. These regulations have been designed with everyone's safety and enjoyment of the park in mind.

Once immunizations have expired, you have one week to update vaccinations and provide paperwork to the office, otherwise your key fob will be turned off until proof of updated vaccinations have been submitted.

The Recreation Authority/MiDOG Organization may revoke dog park privileges for misuse at anytime.

Licensing Guidelines for City of Eastpointe are as follows:

Every property owner or occupant in the City of Eastpointe who possesses, harbors, shelters, keeps, or has custody of any dog is responsible for obtaining a license within 30 days of moving into the City or acquiring a new dog, for any dog that is 4 months old or older, for each dog up to two dogs as permitted by ordinance.

Residents are required to apply for a license on or before March 1st of each year, and must provide a signed Rabies Vaccination Certificate from a licensed veterinarian in accordance with State Law. All dogs shall have and wear at all times a collar with license tag securely attached. To protect the health, safety, and welfare of Eastpointe residents, business owners, and visitors; to prevent unhealthy and unsafe conditions in neighborhoods, and further, in order to notify owners of lost or impounded dogs.

The law governing dogs can be found in Chapter 8 of the "Codified Ordinances of the City of Eastpointe". These ordinances can be reviewed at the Clerk's Office at City Hall, in the Library, online at <http://cityofeastpointe.net>, or a copy may be obtained for the cost of current copy fees. The City enforces the ordinance pertaining to dogs through its Police Officers and an Animal Control Officer, whose duties include investigating and writing tickets to enforce the laws and ordinances concerning animals. The City also employs dog canvassers who check door-to-door for dog licenses each year. The canvassers also issue tickets when dogs are found unlicensed. Licensing Guidelines for City of Roseville are as follows:

- A. The owner of a dog that is four months old shall apply to the Police Chief, or his or her designee, for a license for each dog owned or kept by him or her. Licenses shall be procured for the duration of the rabies vaccination. Any prior licensee who fails to renew an expiring license before 30 days after the current license expires shall be subject to the additional charges.
- B. The applicant must present a rabies certificate which shall state the breed, sex, age, color and markings of the dog and the name and address of the owner. The application for a license shall be accompanied by a valid certificate of a current vaccination for rabies, with a vaccine licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture, signed by an accredited veterinarian. The certificate of vaccination for rabies shall state the month and year of expiration for the rabies vaccination, in the veterinarian's opinion.
- C. The owner of a dog that is required to be licensed under this section shall keep the dog currently vaccinated for rabies by an accredited veterinarian with a vaccine licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture.
- D. The applicant must pay the licensing fee prior to the issuance of the License. There will be a renewal license fee for un-neutered or un-spayed dogs and a renewal license fee for neutered or spayed dogs. A fee will be charged for each duplicate license that is requested.
- E. A dog which is used as a guide or leader dog for a blind person, a hearing dog for a deaf or audibly impaired person or service dog for a physically limited person is not subject to any fee for licensing. This exemption shall extend to "Paws for a Cause."
